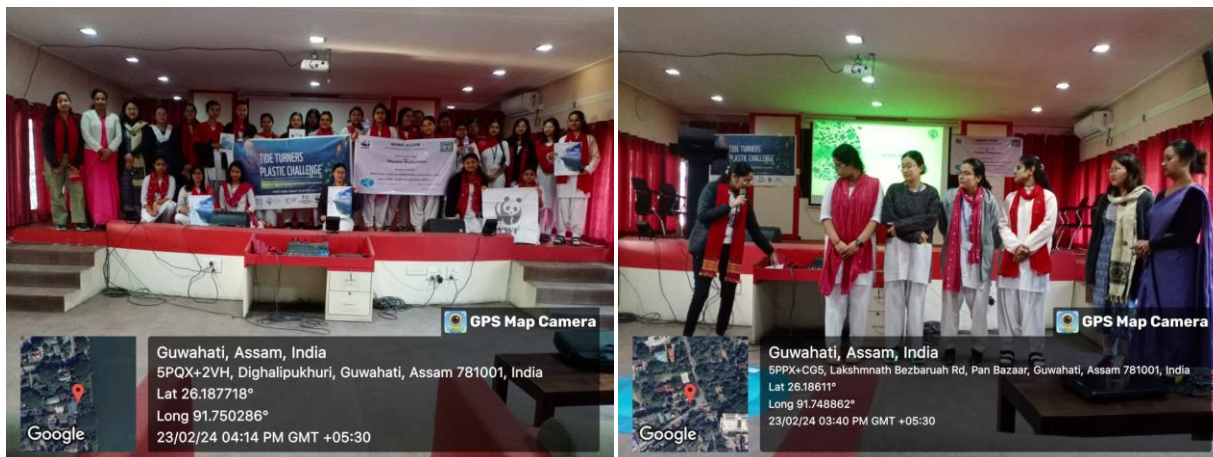

GREEN CLUB

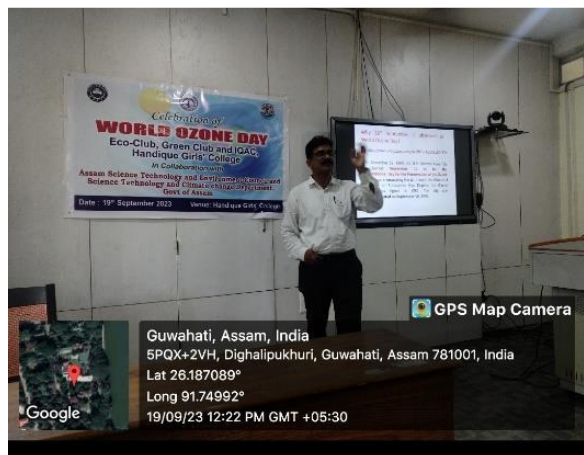

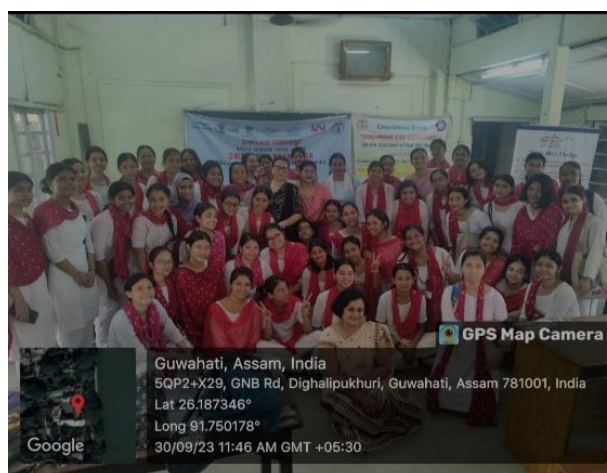
