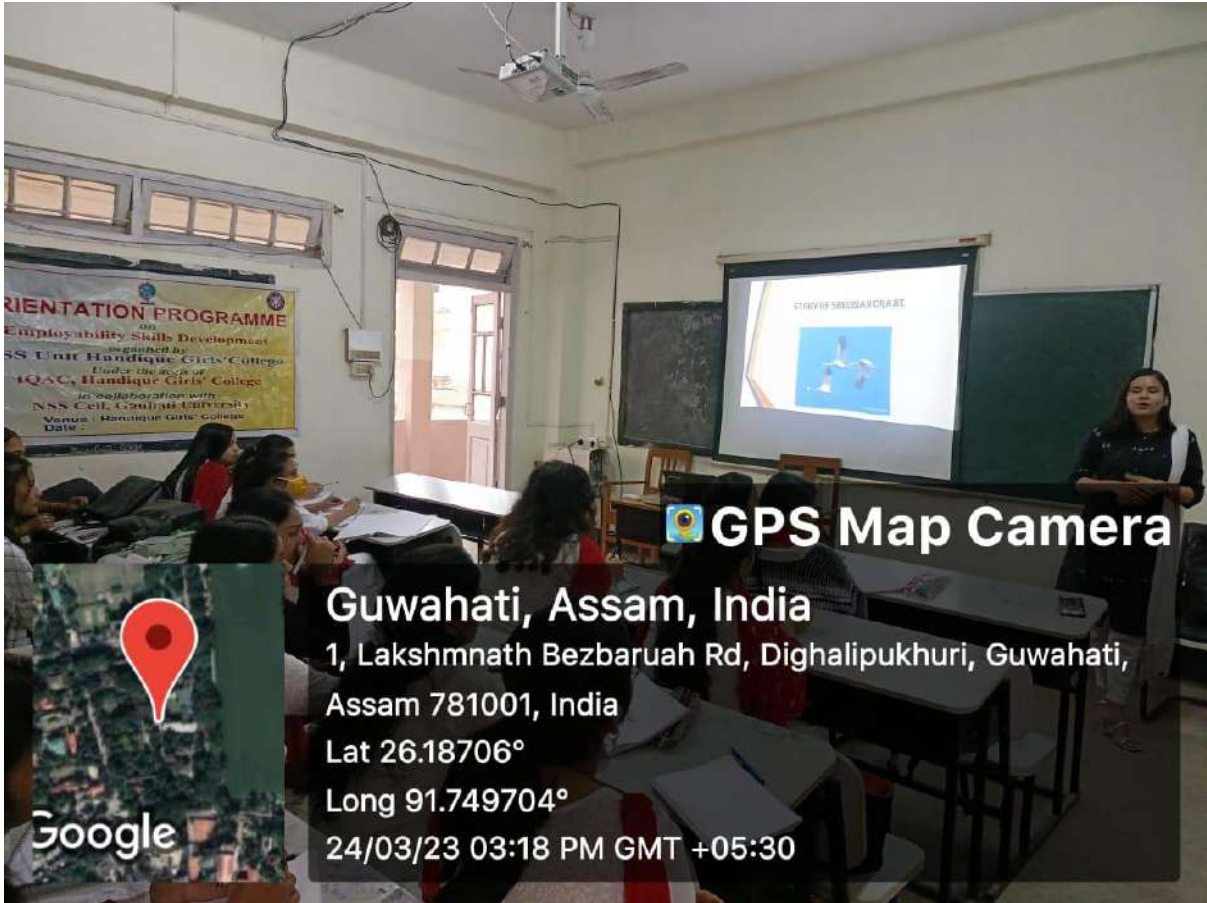
### **Soft Skills Programme**
