DISCUSSION:

- ① Dr Shakeel Zamil, Co-ordinator UG-CBCS, elaborated on the system and the working / functioning of the CBCS. The key points of his presentation were as follows;
- CBCS is a cafeteria approach
 - students will be benefited / student centric
 - uniform grading.
 - Modes of teaching with emphasis to tutorials.
 - Work load fluctuation for teachers.

→ Structure of curriculum

- Core (Major) → 140 credits
- Regular (Pass) → 120 credits

→ 1 credit = 1 class / week

→ Categories of courses —

- Core
- Elective — discipline specific (DSE)
- Ability enhancement course
 - AECC (Compulsory course)
 - SEC (Skill enhancement)

→ Break up of courses

Honors - Core (CC) — 14 course (84 credits)

AECC	— 2 "	(4 ")
SEC	— 2 "	(4 ")
DSE	— 4 "	(24 ")
GE	— 4 "	(24 ")

Regular CC — 12 (72 credits)

AECC	— 2	(4 ")
SEC	— 4	(8 ")
DSE	— 6	(36 ")

→ Students cannot change combinations in the three years of study.

* Dr Mintu Lal Saha interacted with the speaker regarding combinations related to Maths (core)

* Dr Pallavi Debe enquired about the break up of the papers semester wise.

* Dr Pami Hiloidari clarified queries regarding selection of language subjects.

* Dr Madhuchanda C. Bhuyan posed her query choice of subjects by the students.

* Dr Tasneem Iqbal also enquired about the selection of papers.

The teachers interacted with each other regarding the distribution of classes, availability of rooms, time allotment, etc. The Tajanata K. Manta, Convener, Routine discussed with the teachers.

Dr Utpal Dutta, Principal of the college in his concluding remarks encouraged the teachers to look forward towards the challenging times ahead. He highlighted the role of the teachers in easing out the students dilemma. He pointed out that the students will benefit from the flexibility that CDCS will offer; it will aid in the eligibility of students without major to enroll for post graduation.
