Proceeding of the IQAC Meeting held on 01/04/2023

Proceedings of the IQAC meeting held on 01/04/2023 amongst the IQAC Co-ordinators and the Members of the Sub-committee of the IQAC with the Principal:-

- 1. Departments need to maintain consolidated report of field trips or excursions and submit a proper academic report to the IQAC.
- 2. Dr. Kishore Dutta submitted a website design proposal which will be processed.
- 3. Departments need to introduce add-on courses of at least 36 hours duration. HODs will have to submit proposals for add-on courses which will be reviewed by a panel for selection. Fees also need to be collected. Information regarding this needs to be given in the prospectus.
- 4. Standardized Google feedback forms separately for parents, faculty members and office staff need to be created.
- 5. Systematic record of internal assessment, examination related grievances need to be maintained by the departments in a register. A notice regarding this need to be circulated.
- 6. Proposals to consider- "Traditional Knowledge System" as best practice was taken with a vision to evolve it in to a "Traditional Knowledge and Innovative Centre".
- 7. Two days Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) workshop needs to be arranged as soon as possible.
- 8. Fund allotted to IQAC needs to be enhanced and for this purpose a part of the overhead amount of Major Research Projects may be transferred to IQAC fund.
- 9. The responsibility of mentoring BA/BSc regular students will be given to the departments with fewer numbers of students.
- 10. Regarding infrastructural development, doors and windows should be repaired, walls should be repainted and desks should be cleaned or repainted,
- 11. As funds are immediately required, CSR of various companies (like Numaligarh Refinery,, IOD, NEC) should be approached. Proposals to NEC, LIC (SDM) should be immediately submitted.
- 12. MOU web linkages should be done.
- 13. Requirements for the adopted village:
 - a. 2 nos. Of display boards
 - b. 3 nos. Computer with table
 - c. Book shelves for library
 - d. Desk and benches
- 14. One officer/Instructor for computer training may be deputed to the village at least once a week. Students may also be given the responsibility.
- 15. Alumni Meet should be held in the last part of April and a new Committee will be formed.
- 16. Department HODs will be requested to furnish list of alumni in terms of their different categories of occupations.
- 17. Department e-magazines may also be uploaded on the College website.
- 18. Sessional marks should be displayed on the College website.
- 19. Necessary arrangements for e-governance in internal examination process, office and students support need to be done.

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
