

as well. However, maximum participation from the college itself will be expected / encouraged, with 70% students from the college.

2) Although the courses will be optional, students will be motivated to take at least one of these courses as the courses are skill-based with scope for employability.

3) As of now 14 courses are placed as proposals. Seven courses will be introduced in the first phase to be followed by another seven in the second phase. As the funds for running the courses will be collected from the students, the continuity of the courses will depend on the number of students.

4) Guest faculty will take Rs. 700 per class in-house faculty will take Rs. 500 per class and specially invited / guest resource person will be given Rs. 1000.

5) The courses will be conducted by the respective departments.

6) Certificates will be given by the college.

7) Advertisement for motivating the students is emphasized.

8) Different add-on course will charge different rate of course fee and resource-generation will be one of the major objectives of the courses.
